








Praça de Espanha / Gonçalo Telles Urban Park - Project







- 6 hectares;
- Stretch of watercourse renatured with the planting of riparian vegetation on the banks.
- Plantation of over 1000 trees;
- Creation of leisure and recreational areas.
- Inclusion of pedestrian paths and playground;
- Construction of a cycle path with bike-sharing stations.



This new green area connects the Calouste Gulbenkian Foundation Garden with the Monsanto Green Corridor. In total, the project covered 11 hectares and extending the reclaimed water network from the Alcântara WWTP, which will soon enable the irrigation of the new park with reclaimed water.

- Requalification of public space
- Pedestrian routes of continuity and connection with the surrounding urban neighborhoods







After intervention

- Easier and easier car circulation
- Improvement of the BUS corridor
- Integration of a cycling network
- Pedestrian connection between the Gulbenkian and Sete Rios





